Absentee Ballots and Early Ballots for the State Election on Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022, are now available at the Town Clerk's Office.

In order to prepare for the State Election, the Town Clerk's office will be closed the following Mondays: Oct. 10 (Holiday), Oct. 17, Oct. 24 and Oct. 31st

To obtain an Absentee Ballot or an Early Ballot, you must fill out an application with a valid signature for each voter, along with the address as to where the ballot should be mailed. You can obtain an Absentee Ballot Application or an Early Ballot Application online at www.townofnorwell.net or www.mass.gov or call Town Clerk's Office and we can mail an application to you.

IN PERSON Early Voting for the State Election will begin Saturday, Oct. 22nd and end on Friday, Nov. 4th and will be held at the Norwell Town Hall in the Osborn Room. You do not need a reason to early vote.

Thurs. (Oct. 27) – 10 am to 2 pm	Thurs. (Nov. 3) – 8:30 am to 3:30 pm
Fri. (Oct. 28) – 8:30 am to 10 am	Fri. (Nov. 4) – 8:30 am – 11:30 am

The deadline to submit a Vote by Mail application or an Absentee Ballot application for a MAILED BALLOT will be 5 p.m. on Tues., November 1st.
